- 36 bedrooms, all refurbished to a high standard

- Our own beauty salon for pamper sessions and hairdressing

## LIFE AT FLORENCE HOUSE

At Florence House respect, maintaining dignity and independence and person-centred care are at the heart of everything we do.

Activities are a key part of our Home life, and we have a monthly calendar of activities to keep our residents entertained, engaged and socialising together.

Some of our recent activities and events have included: arts and crafts days, animal handling visits, singalongs and visiting performers, a Harvest Festival service and Remembrance Day with a visit from the local school choir, bowling, theme days, gardening, board games, quizzes and bingo activities, pamper sessions and national events and celebrations.

Although we have group activities, we understand that some of our residents enjoy keeping up with their own hobbies and interests and we do everything we can to help them continue with these, whether it's playing a musical instrument, gardening, knitting or something more unusual!

As well as activities within our Home, we organise regular days out where our residents are supported by our care staff and volunteers to go on trips to local attractions such as Gladstone Pottery, Brampton Museum, Hanley Museums, Stafford Arboretum and Trentham Gardens.

We also offer transport services which allow relatives to take their loved ones on day trips as well as providing transport to Florence House when our residents join us for residential care, respite care or day care.



#### MEAL TIMES AT FLORENCE HOUSE

Meal times are at the heart of our life at Florence House. As well as food being part of our social life, we also understand how important good food and nutrition are to the overall wellbeing of our residents.

Every resident is offered a hearty breakfast, mid-morning snack, lunch, afternoon tea and an evening meal. We use fresh produce rather than frozen (where possible) and our menus are varied and change regularly.

All our residents are encouraged to join the community in the dining area at mealtimes, however, if they wish their meals can be served in the comfort of their own room.


Along with all our healthy meals we also have fun with themed suppers, such as Pie and Pint Night, Fish Supper Evening and Olde World Foods.
